We are seeking an exceptional leader to serve as Chair of the Board of Trustees. Someone who brings vision, strategic clarity, and the confidence to guide our organisation through an exciting period of transformation and growth; including a strategic pivot to a new industry-funded regional model, with [Bristol and the South West](#) launched as our first hub in 2026.

As Chair, you will play a pivotal role in steering the Association's long-term direction, strengthening our influence across government, industry, and the education sector, and ensuring we continue to champion high-quality design and technology education for learners nationwide. Central to this is our new regional initiative (backed by leading industry partners including Dyson and Samsung UK) which delivers fully funded support directly into schools, connecting up to 1,700 schools in the South West alone with real-world design, engineering and problem-solving experiences. Bristol is the first of up to 15 planned regional hubs across England and Wales, and the incoming Chair will help shape and govern this national expansion.

- Providing purposeful leadership to the Board, setting a tone of ambition, collaboration and integrity.
- Working closely with our CEO to ensure strong organisational performance, accountability and strategic focus.
- Representing the Association externally, acting as a compelling advocate for design and technology education.

- Guiding the organisation through future growth, navigating external challenges, and enabling innovation.
- Overseeing the national rollout of our industry-funded regional model; governing the expansion from the Bristol and South West hub toward a network of up to 15 regional hubs and stewarding strategic partnerships with industry funders.
